1. Apologies were received by Cllr J Daulby and approved.

Cllr Matthew Taylor reported 1. The Yarmouth Road development will be referred again to NN Dev Cttee

2. Cllr Taylor has reported the social media advertising of Sutton Hall, and it has now been taken down. He has also readdressed the issue of lighting at Sutton and Sutton Mill. 3. Cllr Taylor achieved a good result When he challenged the closure of the public toilets in Stalham in achieving support from the opposition.

4. Norfolk Climate Change initiative have given Cllr Taylor and Cllr Bayes access to infra red cameras. They will be visiting residents in their area(including Sutton) to offer help in identifying heat loss areas from their homes. 5. As a result of Local Government reorganisation District Councils are very likely to be disbanded. There is no information of what this will look like or how and when it will happen. He will keep us in the loop.
